*Braids and plaits were heavily featured on the Spring Summer 2010 runway. Variations included, the fish braid, and the side braid.*

Expert Tip

"The side braid can only be worn with a side parting which must be on the opposite side of the head (to the braid). The hair is parted in to three sections and is braided, sections are loosely tied. This braid has a soft romantic look.

The fish braid can be worn with a centre parting. In this braid the hair is divided into 2 sections. Small sections from either side are brought in the centre and crossed under the other section. " ... Seema Jerajani

Asha Hariharan, colour ambassador Wella Professionals aptly named her interpretation of the Plait and the braid "Ethno-fusion", the style epitomising drama, edginess and festivities with a tribal touch. Hair colour in shades of pink flickering through block blondes or acid bright accents sprawled though desert blondes or red browns completed the look.

Ethno-fusion decoded by Asha Hariharan

1. Create 3 distinct sections
2. The outer 2 sections are classic plaits of 3 sections each. The middle section has been intertwined with an orange plait.
3. The 3 sections have then been woven together to create a braid.
4. Stitch the ends together.
